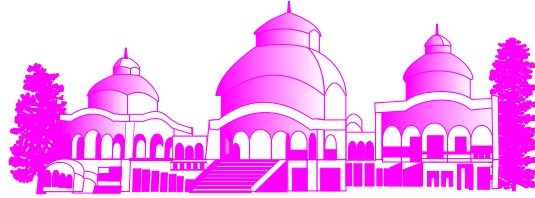

His talk convinced the audience that taking simple precautions and leading an active lifestyle, one can be far away from this air-borne infection.

International Mother's Tongue Day was celebrated jointly by Nikhil Bharat Banga Sahitya Sammelan (Delhi Branch) and Chittaranjan Park Kali Mandir Society, on Sunday, 15th March 2015 at Kali Mandir premises.

Mr. Salahuddin Nomen Choudhury, Deputy High Commissioner, Republic of Bangladesh was the Chief Guest. Welcoming the audience, Shri N.

N. Sarkar, President, gave a brief sketch about Nikhil Bharat Banga Sahitya Sammelan, its activities and the significance of 21st February - International Mother's Tongue Day. Dr. Ananda Mukherjee, Chief Advisor, KMS, talked about one's mother land sync with Mother's Tongue. Bengali Language is now widespread and because of its richness, many Universities in the world have introduced 'Bengali' as one of the subjects. Shri Salahuddin Nomen Choudhury talked about 21st February and its importance that the Bangladesh Govt. attach with this day. He also talked about the common culture, literature, language, life style and bond of friendship between the two countries.
