FROM THE SECRETARY'S DESK Respected Members / Devotees / Readers,

It was my proud privilege to present, before the AGM of KMS my report on the activities undertaken during the year 2016-17, held on Sunday, the May 28th 2017. This was my second successive report, first being for 2015-16 which was presented last year. The year witnessed impressive advancement of the Society: pujas and rituals in great abundance, cultural programmes throughout the year, flower show, donation to Socio-Cultural-Religious-Philanthropic Institutions for their on-going projects, improved services to devotees, decorative terracotta work, extensive repair and white washing of Jatriniwas and numerous other developmental work. Counting of votes will commence after 2.30 p.m. Results will be announced after completion of counting of votes. As KMS is a Socio-Religious-Cultural-Philanthropic Society, it is highly desirable from the respected Members to cast their verdict in favour of a Committee, which is capable of good governance of the Society, possessing skill in Management of its various activities - religious, developmental, cultural, charitable, social welfare and above all responsive to devotees. On 9th May, 2017 KMS celebrated the 156th birthday of Gurudev Rabindranath Thakur in the Muktangan. Songs, Dance and Skits of this noble laurete was conducted by more than 115 Artists from all parts of Delhi who made the audience spellbound.

As notified, the celebrations of the current month include two popular religious festivals, namely, Rathayatra and Bipattarini Brata. With the immense blessings of His Divine Grace Om Vishnupada 108 Tridandiswami Sri Srimat Bhaktisravan Tirtha Goswami Maharaj, KMS has been organizing the popular festival of Rathayatra every year and this year this great event will be organized on Sunday, the 25th June, 2017. Revered Swami Atmajnanda Maharajji, Secretary, Bharat Sewashram Sangha will inaugurate the celebration by pulling the rope of the holy chariot and Abhisekh of Lord Jagannath will be performed by Swami Shantatmananda Maharaj, Secretary, Rama Krishna Mission, Delhi. Sri Sri Bipattarini Puja, predominantly by ladies, will also be celebrated with immense joy and enthusiasm on 27th June and 1st July, 2017 (Tuesday & Saturday respectively). The dates for "Sarodiya Durga Puja, 2017 are from 26th September, 2017 (Tuesday) to 30th September, 2017



Roy - Joint Secretary, Shri Shambhu Bagchi and Shri Pramitabha Barua both Members) prevented a major fire mishap from engulfing J - 1926, C. R. Park on the evening of 27th April, 2017. Seeing the flames and dense smoke emitting there from, they immediately raised a hue and cry which attracted the attention of other Society Members who also joined them in rescue operations in real earnest by arranging much needed water supply and relief work. The Fire Brigade and Police Station was also informed immediately. Due to their prompt action, an octogenarian lady in a wheel chair was rescued and other occupants of the building were evacuated to safety. As a result of their prompt action, the fire was extinguished and major damages prevented.
