FROM THE SECRETARY'S DESK Respected Members / Devotees / Readers,

With the immense blessings of Revered Om Bishnupada 108 Tridandi Swami Sri Srimat Bhatktishravan Tirtha Goswami Maharaj, the originator of Ratahyatra Festival of Chittaranjan Park Kali Mandir Society, the 19th Rathayatra festival of Lord Jagananth was held in the Kali Mandir Complex on Monday, the 25th June, 2017 with tremendous zeal, enthusiasm and deep religious touch. Images of three Deities: Lord Jagannath, Balabhadra and Subhadra (earlier brought from Puri) were got re-fabricated. The Chariot was repainted and tastefully decorated. On the previous evening (24th June), there was a large congregation of devotees. Shrimati Nandini Bhattacharya and her troupe of the Satya Sai Seba Organisation, Delhi Branch, presented melodious devotional songs, cheering the hearts of a large number of devotees. The Kirtanias rendered Harinam Sankirtan creating a Divine atmosphere and transforming the festival site as Shrikhetra (Puri). Revered Swamy Shantatmananda Maharajji, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission (Delhi Branch) performed the rituals of Abhisekh of Lord Jagannath and Revered Swamy Sagar Maharajji, Bharat Sevashram Sangha, New Delhi flagged off the yatra by pulling the rope of the Chariot. In fact, there was heavy rush of devotees for pulling the rope of the chariot. The Chariot, starting from Mandir complex with a large procession, took a 'Parikrama' of Chittaranjan Park and returned to Mandir Complex, wherein the devotees welcomed the Chariot with immense joy.

The Managing Committee also arranged Pushpanjali by the respected Priests to Debi Bipattarini (Debi Durga) and Bratakatha Path after every fifteen miniutes on 27th June, 2017 (Tuesday). Hundreds of devotees, predominantly ladies brought their own Brata Thalis and participated in Brata and attired Bratasutra and listened to holy Bratakatha with rapt attention. As ususal, KMS also arranged Special Coupons and arranged Boxes containing thirteen kinds of fruits and specially cooked Bhog-Prasad.

The month of July. 2017 will continue to remain vibrant with Sri Sri Bipattarni (Durga) Brata (1/7/2017). Sri Sri Satya Narayan Puja (8/7/2017), Sri Sri Shoni Puja (15/7/2017) and Sri Sri Amabasya Kalika Puja (22/7/2017). These festivals will be celebrated and pujas performed in Mandir by maintaining religious sanctity. I would like to have your august presence on these pujas and festivals besides other daily pujas.

As the Biennial Election is round the corner, that is, the date of Election is on Sunday, the 2nd July, 2017 and the result will be declared on the same day. By the time the Newsletter reaches you, I presume, you might get the names of New MC Members. The first thing the New Managing Committee will be engaging themselves in making preparations for the mega festival - Sri Sri Durga Puja which is to be performed from 25th Sepember, 2017 (Monday) to 30th September, 2017 (Saturday) keeping its traditional characteristics. The Broadbased Durga Puja Committee, 2017 as usual will make Durga Puja Festival in Kali Mandir, a memorable event with spontaneous participation of you all, as you know delighting lakhs of devotees expected from all corners of the NCR in this mega

festival is possible only by spontaneous participation of more and more devotees.

RATHYATRA OF LORD JAGANNATH

With the immence blessings of revered Om Vishnupada 108 Tridandi Swami Sri Srimat Bhaktishravan Tirtha Goswami Maharaj, the originator of Rathyatra Festival, Kali Mandir Society celebrated the 'Rathyatra' of Lord Jagannath on Sunday the 25th June 2017 with immence joy and enthusiasm. The day was exceptionally hot and humid. Heat waves were blowing throughout the day, and people preferred to be confined indoor. But the Volunteers, Workers and Sevayats were there in full strength to give the final touches of Rath. The Rath was adorned with three Deities, Lord Jagannath, Balabhadra and Subhadra (earlier brought from Puri) which was re-painted and tastefully decorated. Rev. Swami Shantatmananda Maharaj of Ramakrishna Mission, Delhi performed the rituals of Abhisekh of Lord Jagannath and Rev. Swami Sagar Maharaj of Bharat Sevashram Sangha, Delhi, flagged off the Yatra of the Holy Chariot. There were heavy rush of devotees for pulling the rope of the holy chariot. On the previous evening of Rathyatra, Smt. Nandini Bhattacharya and her troupe of Satya Sai Seba Organisation, Delhi Branch presented melodious devotional songs delighting the devotees.

The Holy Chariot starting from Mandir Complex with a large procession, took a 'Parikrama' of Chittaranjan Park and returned to Mandir Complex, wherein the devotee welcomed the chariot with immense joy. Throughout the entire procession, sweets, cold water was arranged for the processionists.

In the evening there was a large congregation of devotees. The Kirtanias rendered Harinam Sankirtan creating a divine atmosphere and transforming the festival arena as Shrikhetra (Puri).

BIPATTARINI BRATA KATHA

This annual ritual, predominantly performed by ladies, is treated as a very important one in the Mandir Calender. It is organised on two days immediately after Rathyatra. This year it was on 27th June and 1st July. Ladies seek the blessings of Divine Mother Bipattarini (Durga) Devi, hundred of Devotees in Chittaranjan Park and adjoining areas flocked Kali Mandir on these days. They keep fast whole day, come to the temple with pious mind, offer pushpanjali with full religious fervour and seek blessings of Maa Durga to protect their families, relatives, friends and others.

Puja Division made elaborate arrangements for the convenience and comfort of the devotees, who braved the scorching heat and participated in brata. To keep the unbearable heat at bay, 'kanats' wrapped round the Kali Temple acted as a shield to tone down the temperature.

Puja Division made elaborate arrangements for the devotees to offer pushpanjali in an orderly manner. Respected priests chanted the holy Bratakatha Path after every ten minutes and the devotees listened with rapt attention. The participants and visitors were treated with cold lemon water. Packed puja prasad containing thirteen kinds of fruits and specially cooked delicious bhog-prasad were handed over to each Brata participant. A good number of devotees also brought their own brata thali. All the devotees were attired with Bratasutra by the Priests.
