SRI SRI DURGA PUJA

Durga Puja, the mega religious event of the month of October, 2015 was celebrated in the Mandir complex from the 19th to 23rd October, 2015 exhibiting deep religious sentiments and limitless joy. The celebration was started with 'Ananda Mela' (a fair of joy and merriment) on the 19th October, 2015. The emphasis was on age-old Bengali tradition - charming idols in Ekchala, eyecatching pandal with decorative photos of Deities who gave their divine weapons to Maa Durga,

offering of Pushpanjali with 'Jaba' and 'Aparajita' flowers brought in huge quantities by air from Kolkata, preparation and distribution of a variety of Prasad, Bhog and Sandhi Puja with deep religious spirit on October 21, 2015 with 1008 Lotus flowers, 'Saptasati' hom yagna on Mahanavami Day (October 22) and sprinkling of holy 'Shantijal' on 'Bijoya Dashami'. The procession of about forty drummers in the early morning of 'Durgashasti' and 'Sandhya Arati' by three priests on each Puja evening were added attractions. Senior Citizens, in thousands, seated in a special enlarged space, took bhog with great pleasure. Month-long cultural events-competitions / melodious programme of songs and dances presented by local and Kolkata Artistes in the evening of four puja days commencing from 23rd September to 22nd October, 2015 were entertaining.

With all humility, it may be said that Durga Puja in Kali Mandir was a grand event.




MAHISHA, THE ASURA'S KING, OBTAINED FROM BRAHMA A BOON : NO PLANT, HUMAN, ANIMAL,






ALL THE GODS GAVE THEIR DIVINE WEAPON TO THE SUPREME POWER.

EACH OF THE WEAPONS HOLDS SPECIAL SIGNIFICANCE. THE TRISHUL SYMBOLIC OF THE THREE HUMAN QUALITIES - SATWA, RAJAS AND TAMAS. THE 'SUDARSHANA CHAKRA', DENOTES THAT WHOLE WORLD SPINS AROUND HER AND SHE IS COMMANDER OF ALL THAT IS HAPPENING. GODDESS DURGA HOLDS A SWORD IN HER HAND, SIGNIFYING KNOWLEDGE, AS SHARP AS THE BLADE. THE BOW AND ARROWS SYMBOLIZE ENERGY, BOTH POTENTIAL (BOW) AND ARROW (KINETIC). THE THUNDERBOLT **SYMBOLIZES** FIRMNESS, LIKE THAT REQUIRED IN CONVICTIONS. CONVEYS TO THE DEVOTEES THAT THEY NEED TO ATTACK THEIR FEARS AND CHALLENGE IT WITH A FIRMNESS THAT IS UNYIELDING AND FULL OF CONFIDENCE. RESIDES THESE WEAPONS, CONCH EMANATED SOUND OF 'OM'. LOTUS BUD MEANS THAT THE OUT OF THE WORLD OF MURKINESS EMERGES THE TRUTH OF LIFE AND THAT HER DEVOTEES CAN

ON THE END OF THE 8TH & BEGINNING OF THE 9TH DAY OF WAXING MOON, CHANDA AND MUNDA CAME TO FIGHT THE GODDESS. SHE TURNED **BLUE WITH ANGER AND** GODDESS CHAMUNDA LEAPED OUT OF HER THIRD EYE. 

মা মৃনাুয়ী

বর্ষান্তে সাদা মেঘের ভেলা উড়ে যায় এক অজানা দেশের উদ্দেশ্যে। শরতের বাতাস ঢেউ খেলে যায় কাশবনে, শিউলি ফুলের গন্ধ চারদিকে ম ম করে, তখনই আমাদের মনে এক আনন্দের জোয়ার বয়ে যায় মা আগমনীর আগমনের বার্তায়। মা আসছেন, আসবেন, আবার আসবেন বারবার আসবেন।

মন্দির প্রাঙ্গণে মায়ের আগমনীর প্রস্তৃতি শুরু হয়ে যায় আগাস্ট মাস থেকে। পশ্চিমবঙ্গ থেকে কারিগররা এসে শুরু করে দেয় মেরাপ বাঁধার কাজ। গৌবিন্দ তার দলবল নিয়ে শুরু করে প্রতিমা গড়ার কাজ। মহিলারা ভীড় করে শাড়ীর মেলায়, ফুচকা বিক্রেতারা রাস্তার কোনায় কোনায় বসে যায় তাদের সামগ্রী নিয়ে, আর শিশুরা নেচে নেচে তাদের ছড়া শুরু করে – "ঢাই কুর কুর, ঢাই কুর কুর, বাদ্যি বেজেছে, ফুলের গন্ধ এসেছে।"

সাংস্কৃতিক প্রতিযোগিতা — পূজার সাংস্কৃতিক প্রতিযোগিতার কাজ শুরু হয় এক মাস আগে থেকে। অফিস থেকে ফিরে, পোষাক বদলিয়ে বাবুরা তাদের পরিবারদের নিয়ে পোঁছে যান মন্দির প্রাঙ্গণে অনুষ্ঠান উপভোগ করার জন্য, সাথে থাকে গরম গরম কফি, পকোরা, আর জমিয়ে আড্ডার আসর। ৬ বছর থেকে নিয়ে ৮৬ বছর পর্য্যন্ত প্রতিযোগিতারা অংশ গ্রহণ করেণ বিভিন্ন বিভাগে — আবৃত্তি, সঙ্গীত, নৃত্য, বেশরঙ্গ, সুরসঙ্গম, অন্তাক্ষরী, আলপনা, ধূনুচিতে। প্রতিযোগিতা চলে পঞ্চমীর দিন পর্য্যন্ত। তারপর দেখতে দেখতে আনন্দ মুখর চারদিন কেটে যায় দশমী বিহিত পূজা সমাপনে। কালিন্দীকুঞ্জে যমুনার সৈকত সলিলে প্রতিমা নিরঞ্জনের পর, উপস্থিত অগণিত ভক্তবৃন্দ হাত তলে উদাত্ত কণ্ঠে বলেছিলেন "আসছে বছর আবার হবে।"

RECEPTION - The first encounter that the large number of Visitors had on entering the sprawling Puja Mandap was the well decorated, aesthetic Backdrop, smartly dressed ladies and gentlemen in their traditional attire manning the Reception Centre. The Desk officials were always ready to provide information to the Visitors on all the four days. The entire Complex was under CCTV surveillance, closely monitored at the large TV screen installed at the Reception. VIPs like, Arvind Kejriwal, CM, Meenakshi Lekhi, MP, Ramesh Bidhuri, MP, Satish Upadhaya, President, BJP, Virender Kasana, Councillor and Sharmistha Mukherjee, Spokesperson - Congress, graced the occasion. They were greeted with flower bouquets, cup of coffees and escorted to Durga Mandap and Bhog area. They appreciated the entire arrangements.

ANANDA MELA - The maiden event of the four day's festival was Ananda Mela, which was predominantly the region of the ladies. By 2.30 PM all the 120 tables were booked and the ladies started to bring their home made items thereafter. The colourful display of different tables made the Mela an attractive one. The Mela was inaugurated by Ms. Meenakshi Lekhi, MP.

PUJA DIVISION - Inauguration Ceremony of Maa Durga was performed by Swami Shantatmananda, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission in the presence of large number of devotees on the evening of Mahasasthi. The Puja Division had started the preparation of performing different rituals in a disciplined, orderly and with religious fervour, and the expectations of the devotees were foremost in their minds. Special attention was paid by them to conduct the 'Sondhi Puja' in an orderly manner and to see that the devotees participated in a comfortable manner.

PRASAD DIVISION - After Pushpanjali, the devotees expected a spoon of charanamrita and a packet of Prasad. The Prasad Division had to make ready about 8000 prasad packets on the previous days tirelessly. About 30 volunteers worked in a factory like manner in Netaji Subhash hall. Each day, the prasad items were different. They also arranged sweet packets for the devotees on the Shantijal day after sprinkling of holy water.

BHOG DIVISION - At Kali Mandir, Bhog is distributed at four places on Mahasaptami, Mahaastami and Mahanavami days - General counter, Sr. Citizen arena, Special counter for the residents of Chittaranjan Park and the VIP enclosure. In all about 50,000 devotees partook Bhog Prasad on all the three days. In addition to this, 1200 special packed Thalis were also handed over to the devotees. All these were handled by our Bhog and Thali Distribution Division meticulously.

CULTURAL DIVISION - The venue of the cultural programme is the back lawn where the Bhog is distributed. When the bhog distribution was over, the entire area was spruced up and chairs laid for the spectators to enjoy the cultural Programme. This year lot of thinking and efforts were made to cater to all age groups, for which the preparation started two months ahead. Noted artists like Iman Chakraborty, Shreya Guha Thakurta, Angshujit & Abhijit, Shounak Chattopadhyaya, Samik Pal, Manoj Murli Nayyar, Prabuddha Raha and dance drama 'Mirabai' and Folk Song Artists, all from Kolkata presented their programmes. A unique Jatra Pala - which is a

dying art, was also presented on the Navami day titled 'Pagla Thakur' by a well known Jatra Group from Kolkata. Well known local artists like Mihir Basu, Bishaka Basu, Kumar Lala and dance item by Spondon presented their items to the delight of the audience.

STALLS & BANNERS - Welcome Gates, Banners and colourful stalls added glamour to Puja Pandal. Pillars inside the Puja Pandal were wrapped with decorative flex sheets of Maa Durga face sponsored by S Y Associates & State Bank of India, Chittaranjan Park Branch in a big way. Two fully equipped Ambulances were stationed in the Mandir Complex to meet any exigencies, sponsored by 'Max Healthcare' and 'Saket City Hospital'.

SECURITY - During Durga Puja threat perception loomed large on whole of Delhi, hence KMS took it seriously and deployed Private Security Guards, Volunteers equipped with WALKIE-TALKIE in addition to police personnel from C. R. Park Police Station. On account of their strict vigilance, four criminals were apprehended while pick-pocketing. With the blessings of Maa Durga, Durga Puja went off without any untoward incident.

IMMERSION DIVN. - This year Fork Crane was engaged to lift the heavy idol of Maa Durga and other idols safely on the truck. About 1000 devotees, attired in Red T-shirts, donated by a well-wisher, participated in the colourful procession and danced merrily to the tune of Dhak and Kasor.
