# From the Secretary's Desk

Respected Members, Devotees and Readers would recollect that while elaborating the important events held in Mandir premises in the month of February, 2024, I also touched upon the two major events, namely **Closure Ceremony of Golden Jubilee** and **Members' Day** held on 2nd and 3rd March, 2024 and thereafter circulation of Newsletters commenced. Apart from these two major events, the remarkable achievements of KMS during the month of March, 2024were the skillful management of a number of Pujas and Celebrations, Religious Discourses, Cultural Programmes and a Grand Flower Show.

During the month of March, 2024, the major Puja was Maha Shivaratri - a twenty four hour event on 8/3/2024, attracting a large number of devotees from morning till midnight. Our main focus, besides performance of 4 Prahar Pujas was devotee service and to control the continuous flow of devotees in Shiva Temple, orderly way of offerings - ghee, honey, sugar curds, variety of flowers and belpata to Lord Shiva and distribution of fruit prasad during the whole day and also after Sandhya-aarati. With the immense blessings of Lord Shiva and your valuable support and cooperation everything passed off smoothly. Needless to say, on this auspicious day of Mahashivaratri, devotees observed daylong fast, thronged the Shiva Temple from morning with offerings of Panchamrita and bathed the Sureyshwar Mahadeva and offered Pushpanjali. The Mandir complex was tastefully illuminated, resembling it as Kashi Vishwanathdham.

KMS also organised its **Annual Flower Show** in Mandir Complex. **The show opened with a riot of colours delighting the visitors who have noticed the** charming floral display comprising of colourful Dhalias, exotic varieties of seasonal flowers, Cactus, etc. on Shivaratri falling on Friday, 8th March, 2024 was a big draw. The flower arrangement show was equally eye catching. Visitors enjoyed the scene and prefered to name the Exhibition as *Mini Mughal Garden*. Prizes were awarded to winners in the Flower Competition. Encouraging Trophies were also awarded to all the Competitors, besides Judges and Honourable Guests. We at KMS are proud of our Gardeners.

Apart from Maha Shivaratri in the month of March, **Kali Mandir Pratistha Divasiya** was held on 11th March, 2024.

On that day, the Society performed Abhishek, Special Pujas, Yagna and Kumari Puja as per the Shastric embargo. Maa Kali attired in specially prepared garlands along with shining ornaments looked marvellous. Like Maha Shivaratri, Kali Mandir Pratistha Divasiya Puja also attracted a large number of devotees. Decoration of the Temple with flowers, lighting and resounded with Sri Sri Chandi Path, orderly arrangements of pushpanjali and distribution of bhog prasad alongwith your unstinted support made the celebration a well managed affair.

**Dol (Holi) Utsab including Holika Dahan** was another special event in KMS. The Society celebrated Holika Dahan and Holi Utsab on 24th & 25th March, 2024 respectively. Besides splashing of dry colours and distribution of sweets and Bhog, Shantiniketan style song and dance through Prabhat Pheri in C.R. Park was another notable feature in Dol or Basanta Utsab, as is popularly called. The fact remained that the crowd remained disciplined throughout the day.

There were as usual Sri Sri Amabasya Kalika Puja, Sri Sri Satyanarayan Puja and Sri Sri Shoni Puja on 9th, 24th and 30th March, 2024 and these Pujas were celebrated in a befitting manner to the satisfaction of devotees. In the current month, in our regular Puja events, namely, Sri Sri Amabasya Kalika Puja, Sri Sri Satyanarayan Puja and Sri Sri Shoni Puja falling on 8th, 23rd and 27th April, 2024 respectively, we solicit your gracious participation with members of your family and friends in these programmes and festivals as per details in the last page of this Newsletter.

I would like to inform you that like previous years, KMS is gearing its efforts with devotion for celebrations of Sri Sri Neel Puja - resembling as Maha Shivaratri by worshiping Lord Shiva on Friday the 12th April, 2024. This is going to be predominantly a ladies day as they are expected in large numbers, attired in traditional dresses and will make floral offerings to Lord Shiva. I would also like to invite you to assemble in the Mandir Complex at the dawn of of Sunday, the 14th Apri, 20204, being Bangabda, 1431 to participate in the Surya Pronam - obeisance to Sun-God. I am quite sure that many of you have been participating in the lush green lawn of Mandir Complex year after year to get the blessings of Suryadev. Further, on 16th April, 2024 KMS will be celebrating Sri Sri Annapurna Puja. On that day also we again expect a large gatherings like that of Durga Mahastami for puja, pushpanjali and collection of Annakut and Mulbhog.
